Chungneijang Mary Kom Hmangte better known as Mary Kom was born on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1983 in Manipur, to parents who worked in the jhum fields of Manipur .Her rise from the humble fields to becoming India's most successful and well known women boxer, in a largely male dominated sport is inspiring. In school, Kom participated in all types of sports including volleyball, football and athletics. It was the success of Dingko Singh that inspired her to switch from athletics to boxing in 2000. "when I started ,I had no encouragement and no support. It was very difficult because I come from a poor family and I had to struggle a lot for the first four or five years," she recalls. "I never had money to buy a proper kit or good shoes, and I used to travel long distances by bus or train". One of the reasons she took up boxing was to help her dependent family lead a better life She is the only woman to become world's Amateur boxing champion for a record six times and the only woman boxer to have won a medal in each one of the seven world championships. Nicknamed as Magnificent Mary, she became the first Indian woman boxer to win gold at the 2018 Commonwealth Games .On 26 th April 2016, Kom was nominated by the President of India as a member of the Rajya Sabha .
