

VOICE

ACTIVE VOICE

Present Simple –

S + V₁ + O

I eat mango

Present Continuous –

S + is/am/are + V₁^{ing} + O

I am eating mango.

Present Perfect

S + has / have + V₃ + O

I have eaten mango.

Past Simple

S + V₃ + O

I ate mango

Past Continuous

S + was / were + V₁^{ing} + O

I was eating mango.

Past Perfect –

S + had + V₃ + O

I had eaten mango.

Future Simple: -

It will / shall + V₁ + O

I shall eat mango.

Future Perfect

S + will / shall + have + V₃ + O.

I shall have eaten mango.

PASSIVE VOICE

Present Simple –

O + is / am / are + V₃ by

Mango is eaten by me.

Present Continuous –

O + is / am / are + being + V₃

Mango is being eaten by me.

Present Perfect

O + has / have + been + V₃

Mango has been eaten by me.

Past Simple

O + was / were + V₃ + by

Mango was eaten by me

Past Continuous

O + was / were / being + V₃

Mango was being eaten by me

Past Perfect –

O + had + been + V₃ by

Mango had been eaten by me.

Future Simple: -

O + will / shall + have + been + V₃

Mango will have been eaten by me

Future Perfect

O + will / shall + have + been + V₃

Mango will have been eaten by me.
